

Monthly Citizenship Award Criteria

1. Leadership

The child demonstrates traits of being a positive role model. For example, the child motivates and guides others, is a self-starter, and demonstrates a positive attitude.

2. Volunteerism

The child freely takes part in tasks at school and in the community.

3. Perseverance

The child demonstrates persistence in performing difficult tasks.

4. Sportsmanship

The child consistently demonstrates fair treatment of others on and off the playing field and playground.

5. Empathy

The child consistently demonstrates care and understanding for the feelings, thoughts, and attitudes of others.

6. Perfect Attendance

During the calendar month, the child attends 100% of each school day (no lates or early departures). Students marked as “school excused” are considered in attendance.

7. Organization

The child consistently demonstrates proficient organizational habits in their desks and lockers, and is prepared for class.
