Background

Allan Quick farmed in the Landonville area, north of Clandonald. He was a very community minded man and, as such, this scholarship is set up to assist students from Allan's home community and surrounding area, who graduated from high schools in the former County of Vermilion School District. This scholarship rewards positive results in studies related to agriculture at Lakeland College.

Locations: Dewberry, J.R. Robson, Marwayne, Kitscoty or E.H. Walter

Amount: The amount will be the value of the interest received from the investment each year. This is approximately \$1500.00-\$2000.00 per year.

Award Criteria:

1. Student must have graduated from one of the above listed schools.
2. Preference will be given to students with a farming background who grew up closest to Allan's farm on the SW-6-55-5 W4 in the Landonville area.
3. Student must be enrolled in a minimum two year program to maximum four year program at Lakeland College- Vermilion or Lloydminster campus.
4. Students must supply a letter from Lakeland College proving successful completion of first, second, third or fourth year courses (students are eligible to apply for this award following completion of each year of their program).
5. Students must also include the following with their application:
 - a. A letter of reference from their high school principal, teacher or college instructor.
 - b. A list of academic achievement and community involvement throughout high school and while attending college.
 - c. A brief explanation of how their future career will relate to agriculture.
 - d. Legal land location of their family farm home quarter (if the student has a farming background).
