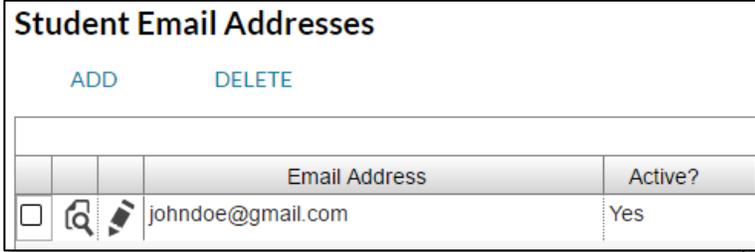
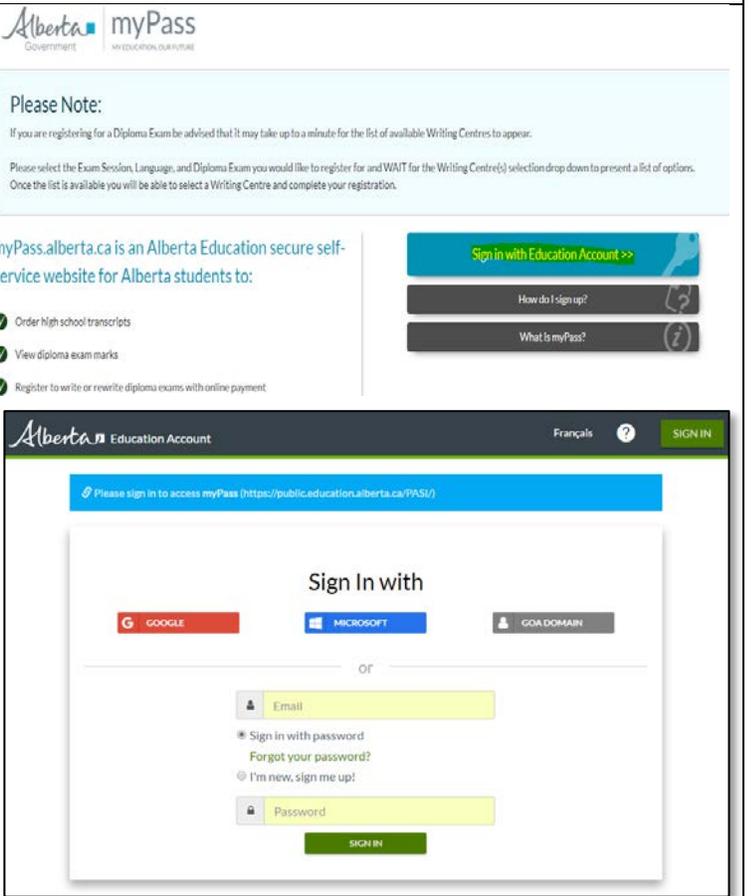

1. Student Definition and overview how to connect to myPass

Who can have access to myPass?		
Student		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any student from age 13 or older.
How to connect to myPass?		
Student age below 13		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • myPass is not available for students below age 13. • myPass provides most added value to students that are attending High School. Most students that are attending high school are 13 years or older. The Parent/Guardian can get access to student information in myPass for students below age 13.
Student age above 13	Signup with email match	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School enters the Student personal Email address to PASIprep. • Student creates an Education Account with an email address that match the email address registered by the School in PASIprep • Student enters the correct Alberta Student Number and Date of Birth in myPass.
	Signup with Access Code	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student receives the Signup Access code by letter via mail for the following situations: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Email address that is used for the Education account does not match the Email address in PASIprep or there is no email address in PASIprep. The student is unable to establish a myPass connection and has the option to request an Access Code. OR 2. The Student is registered for a diploma exam, but does not have a myPass account <p>For both situations the student should have a current mailing address in PASIprep.</p> • Student creates Education Account. • Student enters the correct Alberta Student Number and Date of Birth in myPass. • Student enters the provided Sign up access code in myPass.

2. Detailed overview – How to connect a student to myPass?

2.1 Student - Signup with email match

<p>Step 1: Enter Email address in PASIprep</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> School enters or confirms the student email address in PASIprep. 	
<p>Step 2: Create/Sign in to myPass</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The school instructs the student to create an Education Account with an email address that match the email address registered in PASIprep The student visits the myPass website via mypass.alberta.ca, or simply searches 'myPass' in browser. The Student clicks on “Sign in with Education Account.” The Student signs in with the Education Account, or with a Google or Microsoft Account. 	

Step 3: Enter details in myPass

- The student enters the following information:
 - ASN
 - Date of Birth
 - Select the option "The Student"
 - Click "Activate Connection"
- The student receives an email notification with details that an active connection has been created on their record.

2.2 Student - Signup with Access Code

Step 1: Receive of Sign up Access Code letter

- Student receives the Signup Access code by letter mail for the following situations
 - The Email address that is used for the Education account does not match the Email address in PASIprep or there is no email address in PASIprep. The student is unable to establish a myPass connection and has the option to request an Access Code.

OR

 - The Student is registered for a diploma exam, but does not have a myPass account.

For both situations the student should have a current mailing address in PASIprep.

If you cannot obtain access to myPass, your diploma exam results can be obtained through your school or by contacting Alberta Education's Transcripts and Diplomas Office, using the contact info below.

Step 2: Sign Education Account

- The student visits the myPass website via mypass.alberta.ca, or simply searches 'myPass' in browser.
- The Student clicks on "Sign in with Education Account."
- The Student signs in with the Education Account, or Google or Microsoft Account
- Preferable the student uses the same personal email address as the email address that is registered in PASIprep by the school.

Please select the Exam Session, Language, and Diploma Exam you would like to register for and WAIT for the Writing Centre(s) selection drop down to present a list of options. Once the list is available you will be able to select a Writing Centre and complete your registration.

Step 3: Enter details in myPass

- The student enters the following information:
 1. ASN
 2. Date of Birth
 3. Select the option "The Student"
 4. Enters the provided Signup Access Code from the Access Signup Letter
 5. Click "Activate Connection"
- If the entered information matches exactly with student record, the student is informed that 'Access to the student record has been granted'.
- The student will receive a notification email with details that an active connection has been created on their record.

Step 4: View Connection details

- The student is able to view the details of the connected parent/guardian or authorized user in the “Access to the Student Information” section of myPass
 - Personal details including name, relationship and email address.
 - The status of the connection (if one exists)
 - Last time the connection was used
 - The expiration date of the connection

Step 5: Manage existing myPass Connection

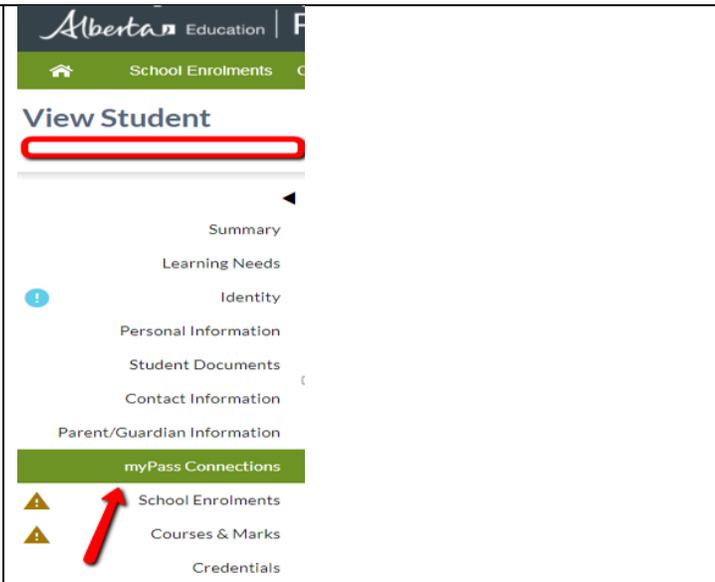

3. Manage Student Connections in PASIprep

<p>Step 1: Select myPass Connection PASIprep</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Go to “myPass Connections” Section in the PASIprep menu 	
<p>Step 2: Manage myPass Connections</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The user can select the following options in the menu: Suspend: Allows the user to suspend an active myPass connection Reactivate: Allows the user to reactivate a suspended myPass connection Delete: Allows the user to delete an active, expired or pending myPass connection. For Suspending, Reactivating or Deleting an existing Connection: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Select the connection that needs to be changed Click “Suspend”, “Reactivate” or “Delete” The status of connection will be changed after user click “YES”
